"With Schools shut, there's no boundary between the bedroom and classroom anymore."

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is defined as illness caused by a novel coronavirus now called severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-COV-2) which was first identified amid an outbreak of respiratory illness cases in Wuhan City, Hubei Province, China. After China it affects mostly all countries in the world, the first case of the COVID-19 pandemic in India was reported on 30 January 2020. As of 18 May 2020, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare have confirmed a total of 55,940 cases, 30,158 recoveries and 2,752 deaths in the country. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, on 24 March 2020, the Government of India under Prime Minister Narendra Modi ordered a nationwide lockdown, which affect educational system worldwide, leading to the near closures of schools, universities and colleges.

We are living amidst what is potentially one of the greatest threats in our lifetime to global education, a gigantic educational crisis. As of March 28, 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic is causing more than 1.6 billion children and youth to be out of school in 161 countries. This is close to 80% of the world's enrolled students. We were already experiencing a global learning crisis, as many students were in school, but were not learning the fundamental skills needed for life. The World Bank's "Learning Poverty" indicator - that children who cannot




