#### 21. **Out of Bound:**

- (a) All Officers/ANOs/PI Staff and Civilian Staff office/line are out of bounds for Cadets.
- (b) All Cinema Halls and roadside hawkers are placed out of bound for Cadets during the entire duration of the camp. Defaulters will be dealt with severely by the Camp
- (c) Girls' enclosures living areas are strictly out of bounds for SD/JD Cadets, male civilian staff and all ranks.

- 30. Prohibition: The following are prohibited during the camp: -
  - Carriage of any private arms / weapons such as knives which may cause injury to the (a) Cadets.
  - PI Staff living tents are placed out of bound for all Cadets. (b)
  - Move out of camp area without written permission of the Camp Commandant / Dy Camp Commandant.
- Visitors will not be permitted to visit the camp. However, the parents / 31. Visitors: guardians

will be permitted to visit the Cadets, as intimated. They may visit the camp between 1700 hrs to 1800

hrs. They will not be allowed to come to living areas. No cadet will leave the Camp area with their parents / visitor without prior permission of the Camp Commandant.
