#### **Counselling:**

Our college invites subject experts, Resource persons, and counsellors to interact with the students. Time-to-time one day workshops and Vaidik Chintan programms are organised for counselling the girls students. Doubts, problems and questions raised by the students are redressed with the help of teachers and other experts of the different areas.

One day or weekly camps for the volunteers, World Aids Day, Teachers Day,

Women Cell, Legal Literacy Cell & Sveep Cell: Celebrates International Womens' Day, Voters Day, Seminars & Workshops related to women issues are also organised. Science Forum, Hindu Sahitya Parishad, Sanskrit Sahitya Parishad, Punjabi Sahitya Parishad & Tourisms Department of the college celebrate National Science day, World environment day, World health day, Hindi Diwas, Sanskrit Diwas and World Tourism Day.

Eco Club: Celebrates clean campus green campus day. Distribution of medicinal plants and fruit plants to the students.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell: Organises various extension lecturers and mock tests to prepare the students for various competitive exams.

#### **Evidence of success**

Many students of this institution have joined various social service groups and reputed NGO's. Through these groups students provide their services to the needy & poor. Trees are planted by the students in the surrounding parks and colonies. Door-to-door convenssing and Nukkad Natak are performed regarding cleanliness. Free Coaching and health tips are given to the needy and poor people by our volunteers. Maximum attendance of the students during National festivals is observed in the campus. #### 2. Emphasis on morality- perspective and multidimensional approach

Students are future of India. The future of a country depends on the moral values imparted to them in their student life. Our institution tries to apprise the students to the wider aspects of morality and its much dimensional effects. Morality is neither religious nor spiritual. It denotes values. Students are made to grasp the things so that their life style and social approach should not be based on religious dogmas but on ethics.

#### The Practice

'Vedic Yajna' is regularly performed in our institution. Students, teachers and non-teaching staff is systematically trained from time to time by organizing workshops on 'Vedic Sanskriti', 'Vedic Chintan' and the importance and need of moral values.

In Yajna, the light from the flame of the fire is a symbol of knowledge replacing ignorance. Enlightenment of mind is enhanced by the act of chanting mantras. This form of prayer not only brings peace to the soul but its daily repetition is also an act of mental concentration that enables the mind to memorise the wisdom contained in the vedic mantras.

7.4 Contribution to environmental awareness / protection
