## ADMISSION CONCESSIONS FOR COLLEGES/INSTITUTES MAINTAINED/ AFFILIATED WITH THE KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY FOR UNDER-GRADUATE AND POST-GRADUATE COURSES FOR THE SESSION 2018-19

I. In addition to the sanctioned seats, additional seats for the following categories will be as under :

(i) Two additional seats in P.G. courses including Law (3 Yr.) & Integrated courses and 10 seats in Arts, 05 seats in Science and 05 Seats in Commerce in TDC Part-I over and above the sanctioned seats for the outstanding sports persons (except the courses in which admissions are being made by the Haryana State Counseling Board/A.I.E.E.E.) w.e.f. the session 2018-19 as per the following criteria :

### 1. NORMS, GUIDELINES & CRITERIA TO DECIDE THE MERIT FOR OUTSTANDING SPORTS PERSON FOR 2 ADDITIONAL SEATS IN P.G. COURSES INCLUDING LAW (3 YR.) & INTEGRATED COURSES

**Norms For Outstanding Sports Person** : Outstanding Sports Person means a person who has atleast represented the University or State in the Inter University or Senior National Level Championship or above. This include (Senior National, Federation Cup, National League, Inter Zonal National, National Games/National University Games during the course of his/her Graduate/Post Graduate studies).

#### Guidelines for Sports Seats

Sports Certificate for admission will only be considered, if the candidate produce the Gradation Certificate from the respective Govt. in respect of the game/sports for which the candidate claim outstanding sports person seat.

In case any state does not issue the Gradation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted :

- In case of International/National participation or Position Holder, a certificate of authenticity will be required from concerned National Federation/State Association.
- In case of Inter University Participation or Inter University Position Holder other than Kurukshetra University, a certificate of authenticity from the Head of Sports of the concern University will be required.
- The game/event must be in the scheduled list of Association of Indian University Sports Calendar.
- The tournament must be organised by recognised Federation/Association duly affiliated with State Olympic Association/Indian Olympic Association and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- Achievement during the course of Graduate and Post-Graduate studies will be considered for admission in Post-Graduate courses including Law (3 Year).
- No sports achievement lower than the above will be considered for admission for outstanding sports person category, even if the seats remain vacant.

#### Criteria to decide the Merit

- In case of tie in the sports achievement level then the maximum number of achievements at the same level of the minimum eligibility under sports criteria will be taken into account for deciding the merit.
- If still there is tie, then the marks obtained in the Entrance Test will be considered for deciding the merit.
- If still there is tie, then the marks obtained in the Qualifying Exam. will be considered for deciding the merit.
- If still there is tie, then the age will be considered for the merit. (Higher in the age will be considered for the merit).



## II. Distribution and Reservation of Seats :

### (A) Distribution of seats

The seats shall be distributed as under :

- (1) All India Category including Haryana : 15%
- (2) Bonafide Residents of Haryana : 85%

(50% of the seats earmarked for bonafide residents of Haryana will be reserved for the categories as mentioned at (B) below, as per State Govt. policy and remaining 50% seats will be filled from among Haryana General Category)

### (B) Reservation of seats for Bonafide Residents of Haryana

The seats shall be reserved for the categories as under :

(i)	Scheduled Castes	20%
(ii)	Backward Classes of Haryana (except Socially advanced persons/Sections (creamy layer))	27% (16 % for Block-A) (11 % for Block-B)
(iii)	Differently Aabled	03% If the seats reserved for differently abled persons remain vacant due to non-availability of suitable differently abled candidates, it may be offered to Ex-servicemen and their wards (1%) and dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%).
(iv)	Further 3% horizontal reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of General category, 1% out of Scheduled Castes and 1% from Backward Classes category for admissions to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided/institutes located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Classes category is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes are given seats in the Academic Year 2018, the next Block i.e. B Block of category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2019 and so on. The concerned Chairperson/Director of the Department/Institute shall maintain a roster register for horizontal reservation of Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighter & their dependents and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the year. As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided to the concerned category.	

- (v) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from a University in the State of Haryana will be deemed to be Residents of Haryana and will not be required to submit certificates of bonafide residents of Haryana.

### (C) Guidelines for Reservation :

1. The Reservation of seats is as per the Reservation Policy of the Haryana Govt. and is subject to any change/amendment made by the State Govt. from time to time.
2. If the reserved seat(s) of BC Block-A remain vacant, these will be filled up from BC Block-B and vice-versa. The vacant seats of SC category will not be converted into general seats.
3. Certificate of SC category and the Backward Class (Block 'A' & 'B') to be submitted by the candidates on the prescribed proforma alongwith the Admission Form. The BC candidates (Block 'A' & 'B') for benefit of reservation shall also have to furnish an affidavit to the effect that he/she is not covered under the criteria of creamy layer. The said affidavit shall be furnished both by the father and mother of the candidate issued during the current year.
4. If a candidate of Haryana General, SC and BC also apply for Differently Aabled/ESM/DFP category will be considered first for Haryana General, SC and BC category.
5. Dependents of Freedom Fighters of Haryana are required to submit a certificate from the concerned Deputy Commissioner.

6. Only candidates having permanent disability of not less than 40% (being otherwise fit for admission to the course) will be considered for admission. Differently Abled Disability Certificate must be from the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned District.
7. Ex-servicemen and their wards of Haryana are required to submit the certificate from the concerned District Soldier Board.
8. All the eligible candidates whether from Haryana or from Reserved Categories may also compete for seats allocated under All India Category. The candidates of reserved categories should be considered first for Haryana General Category seats.
9. If the number of seats in any particular category is not a round figure 0.5 above will be taken as one and less than 0.5 shall be ignored.
10. Under physically handicapped category atleast one candidate will be admitted, even if, the share is less than 0.5 seat.
11. The seats remaining vacant under various reserved categories other than the SC category shall be converted into General category only if upto the day of display of final list no candidate belonging to reserved categories is available for admission.

### III. Scholarship/Stipends

The eligible SC/ST, OBC and PwD Students etc. should submit their Scholarship Form for the Academic Year as per guidelines issued from time to time.

#### Promotion of Science Education (POSE) Scholarship Scheme for Students of UG and PG Sc. Courses :

In order to encourage meritorious students towards science education and to support them for continuation of their science education upto higher level, Department of Science & Technology provides Scholarships to the 3-Yr. B.Sc./4-Yr. BS/5-Yr Integrated M.Sc./M.S. courses and 2-Yr. M.Sc. course students opting for basic and natural science subjects viz. (1) Physics ; (2) Chemistry; (3) Mathematics ; (4) Biology ; (5) Statistics ; (6) Geology ; (7) Astrophysics ; (8) Astronomy ; (9) Electronics ; (10) Botany ; (11) Zoology ; (12) Bio-Chemistry ; (13) Anthropology ; (14) Microbiology ; (15) Geo-physics ; (16) Geo-chemistry ; (17) Atmospheric Science & (18) Oceanic Sciences. 150 Students each of B.Sc. 1<sup>st</sup> Yr. and M.Sc. (P) are selected on merit basis. Scholarship of Rs. 4000/- per month in a year to B.Sc. students and Scholarship of Rs.6000/- per month once in a year is provided to M.Sc. students. ### IV. Relaxation of the condition of eligibility :

- (i) Unless otherwise specifically provided in the concerned Ordinance, the eligibility condition for Scheduled Castes will be minimum pass marks in the qualifying examinations for admission to a course.
- (ii) In case where specific relaxation of 5% marks in the eligibility condition is to be given to SC/ST/Blind/Visually/Differently Abled etc. candidates, the minimum less marks against 55%, 50% and 45% marks shall be calculated as under :-  
 $55 \text{ marks} - 2.75 \text{ marks} = 52.25 \text{ marks } (5/100 \times 55 = 2.75) ;$   
 $50 \text{ marks} - 2.50 \text{ marks} = 47.50 \text{ marks } (5/100 \times 50 = 2.50) ;$   
 $45 \text{ marks} - 2.25 \text{ marks} = 42.75 \text{ marks } (5/100 \times 45 = 2.25) .$

However, this relaxation is not applicable for LL.B. Professional-3 Yr. and B.A. LL.B (Hons.)- 5 Yr.
