

She emphasized the equally important role of women in development and growth of society comparing both genders are two wings of a bird.

Advocate Susan Anand expressed her concern that even after 67 years of independence we have not been resolve the simple problems like empowerment and girl foeticide. She held the family, the media and even the judiciary responsible for the present plight of woman and assured the audience that if the discharge their responsibility sincerely, the fate of woman, indeed be improved and make the society get rid of the said evils. She summed up her lecture by a quote "the world suffers not by violence of bad people but by silence of good once".
