Annual Report 2018-2019

Orientation Programme

Two days orientation programme for entry level students was organized on 18.07.2018 in Dayanand Mahila Mahavidyalaya as directed by Directorate of Higher Education, Haryana. The programme was started with Hawan and Mantrocharan. Mrs. Urmila Singh, the convener, presented detailed information about the programme. Various activities were organized under the supervision of the convener of the club, Dr. Himani and members Mrs. Sapna Malik, Mrs. Saroj Bala, Mrs. Neelam, Mrs. Ritika during session 2018-19.

On 29.08.2018, a Slogan Writing Competition was organized by the Electoral Literacy Club and Political Science Society on the topic 'Right to Vote'.

On 21.09.2018, a Rangoli Competition was organized on the topic 'Voting Right'. On 05.10.2018, a Speech Competition was organized on the topic 'My Vote, My Heritage'. On 20.10.2018 an Essay Writing Competition was organized and on 25.10.2018 a District Level Essay Writing Competition was organized.

On 03.10.2018, Kajal received 3rd prize from Arya Kanya, KKR and on 09.10.2018, Shalu Saini got the 3rd prize in State Level Competition held at University College, Kurukshetra.

On 25-26.10.2018 a camp was organized to fill the new voter registration forms (form no. 6) in which 102 students at college got registered to get the Voter ID Card. On 15.01.2019, in the district election office Kurukshetra, online practice for EVM-VVPAT was conducted for students and teachers.

On 21-25 Jan. 2019, on the National Voter Program, a Rangoli Competition, Declamation Competition and Poem Recitation Competition was organized in which the students participated extensively. The skit was organized by the students on the fourth day in the series of National Voters Day programmes. The purpose of which was just to create awareness about Voter and Voting. The Principal of the college Dr. Vijeshwari Sharma made the girls aware of the Voter and Voting. On this occasion, a poster making competition was organized in which Riya (M. Com I) got the 1st, Shweta (B.A II) got the 2nd and Deepa (B.A.III) got the 3rd prize.

On 25.01.2019, a district level voters day function was organized in the panchayat Bhawan, Kurukshetra. 30 students at the college attended this. Various district level competitions were organized in which first three positions were honored by the District Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra. In Essay Writing Competition, Akanksha got the 1st, Shalu in Rangoli got the 2nd, Kajal in Rangoli got the 3rd and Shalu Saini in the declamation competition got the 3rd prize.

On 01.02.2019, 96 students got themselves registered to get a new voter registration ID Card. On 18, 20 and 21 Feb. 2019 three days camp was organized to get new voter registration forms filled.

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On 11 to 16 March 2019 six days camp was organized to fill new voter registration forms in which 39 students registered to get the identity card.

In this way, the Electoral Literacy Club plays a very important and useful role in making girls literate and making their voter ID Card during session 2018-19.

Scholarship Society Report

For providing benefits of various schemes being run by the government with the aim of promoting the schemes of scholarship for the upliftment of meritorious students, economically weaker girls, SC, and BC for disabled students' dependents of freedom fighters, under the instructions of the convener of the society Dr. Upasana Ahuja and members Dr. Suman Rajan, Mrs Shilpa Garg and Dr. Sapna Kalia, a scholarship society was organized during session -2018-19; the following scholarship were provided:

- 1. Post Matric Scholarship stipend for BC, the forms of total 220 SC girls and 83 BCwere submitted online.
- 2. Under Haryana state Merit scholarship, total 3 students of MA (English) got an amount
- 3. Under the Radha Krishna scholarship, 17 students of 1st year and 6 students of 2nd and 3rd year filled the form and were sent for the renewal.
- 4. To increase the interest in science 4 students filled the form of POSE (Promotion of Science Education) scholarship.
- 5. Based on university merit, 5 girl students forms were sent for renewal
- 6. On the National scholarship portal 5 students filled the online merit-cum-means
- 7. In addition to various schemes of the government, the college provides some money for the purpose to promote education of financially and economically weaker students and some amount of scholarship was also given to them by individuals also (NGO). As this year, students who got 85% and above marks based on 10⁺² results, every student who got 80% and more marks in university education in 1st and 2nd year of graduation and the students who secured 70% and above marks in graduation 1st and 2nd year and 65% and above in post-graduation 2nd year got Rs. 2000 as incentives. Apart from this, economically weaker students of Arts, Commerce, Science, Tourism and MA streams a cash of Rs. 2000/-, 2500/-, 3000/- respectively was provided for the above assistance. If all the sisters are in the same college, the youngest sister will be benefited with the help of the scholarship.

This year, in merit scholarship total 67 students got Rs. 1,34,000 and 5 Economically Weaker students got Rs. 23,976/. Apart from this, based on Merit-cum-means scholarship some

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students of general category were benefited in which 25 students got help of Rs. 84500 which are as follows:

- 1. Rs 12,500 (Sh. B.D. Munjal) were given to 5 students under Km. Sangeeta Munjal Memorial scholarship.
- 2. Rs 10,000 were given to 2 students from commerce stream under Smt. Kaushalya Mohinder Oberoi Memorial Scholarship (got by Smt. Anju Chawla, Associate Professor, Department of commerce).
- 3. Rs 10,000, were given to 2 students of commerce stream under Smt. Arti Chhabra Memorial Scholarship (got by Smt. Sapna Malik, Associate Professor, Department of commerce).
- 4. Rs 20,000 were given to 4 students of commerce stream under Smt. Pushpa Devi and Sh. Medhraj memorial scholarship (Smt. Usha Malik and Smt. Sai Dass Malik, Businessman, Panipat).
- 5. Rs 5,000 were given to the top scorer student of B.A.I Functional English under Sh. Babu Singh memorial scholarship (got by Dr. Vijay Lakshmi Singh).
- 6. Rs 1,100 were given to the best athlete under Smt. Mahima Chaudhari Memorial scholarship (got by Ch. Bhagwan Dass, member, Arya Shiksha Samiti, D.M.M. Kurukshetra).
- 7. Several schemes are implemented to promote the sports students. Rs 2,50,671 were given to 33 Sports students in the form of freeships.

Library committee

Under the supervision of Dr. Pooja Sharma, convener of library committee, the college library, Shaheed Bhagat Singh ke dada Sardar Arjun Singh memorial library has been functioning successfully.

Book Bank facility is also provided to the students by the library. This facility is provided to those students who have secured 85% or more marks in the previous class or who are not financially capable to buy the books. With this facility, the students are encouraged and able to achieve their goals of life by getting education. Every year a quiz competition is organized by the library committee on Sarvapalli Radha Krishnan's birthday and teachers' day. This competition is based on the newspapers available in the library and runs throughout the years and student's participation is also appreciated. The purpose of this competition is to increase the knowledge of the students day by day and make good use of their valuable time by going to the library. The result of competition of this year are as follows:

Counseling and Psychotherapy
