Scholarship Committee Report

(2019-20)

For providing benefits of various schemes run by the government with the aim of promoting the schemes of scholarship for the meritorious students, economically weaker girls, and different schemes of government for the students belonging to schedule and Backward class, a scholarship committee under the supervision of Dr. Upasana (Convener) and the other members Mrs. Prabhjot Kaur, Ms. Vinita, Ms. Arjita, Ms. Priya, Ms. Manisha was constructed and the following scholarships were provided.

- In post-matric scholarship/ stipend scheme of Govt. for Backward classes, an amount of Rs. 2546605/- was received by 211 SC students and an amount of Rs. 576990/- was received by 214 BC students as stipend.
- 10 students of the college received Rs. 30000/- from Radha Krishan scholarship fund from K.U.K.
- One student received Rs. 24000/- as scholarship under POSE (Promotion of Scheme Education scheme by Govt. of Haryana.)
- On the National scholarship portal, 7 students filled the online merit-cum-means scholarship form.
- One student got Rs. 3600/- as Haryana State merit scholarship by DGHE, Panchkula.
- 4 students of the college received Rs. 9600/- under university Merit Scholarship Scheme of K.U.K.

In addition to various schemes of the government, the college also provide help to financialland economically weaker students of the college. Also some N.G.O's/Philanthropers give donations to provide to help the needy students and also some money is donated for rewards for the highest scorers in particular subjects, Meritorious students and sports students of the college are also recognized through Meritorious scholarship/ scholarship to sports students scheme of the college.
