IQAC

All the members of IQAC worked hard to prepare for the Peer Team Visit of NAAC to complete the ongoing process of Assessment and Accreditation as started w.e.f. 20/05/2021 with the submission of IQA and further submission of SSR on 18/07/2021 on the NAAC portal. PTV was scheduled to be held on 22-23 November, 2021. Various meetings were held for discussion, planning and implementation for the successful Peer Team visit under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajender Vidyalankar, President, Governing Body and Dr. Vijeshwari, Principal of the college. Under the able guidance of respected President Sir and respected Principal Madam, the whole process was completed successfully and college was accredited with prestigious 'A' grade with CGPA 3.12 by the NAAC.

On 27.12.2021, Under the M.O.U. executed with S.D. College, Ambala Cantt, an interactive session on “Sharing Experiences of NAAC Accreditation Process” was organised by the S.D. College in collaboration with our college. Mrs. Anju Chawla, Convener IQAC and Dr. Anu Sharma, co-convener, PEER Team visit were invited as spokesperson to elaborate and share the experience of NAAC accreditation process including IQA, SSR submission, DVV clarification and PEER Team visit. It was an illuminating interaction to learn from each other.

Under Faculty Development Programme, A workshop was organised on the topic “E-content Development and ICT Tools for teaching” jointly with Dept. of Computer Sciences from 31.03.2022 to 11.04.2022. The main objective was to make the teaching more effective and efficient by using advanced and sophisticated ICT Tools. To fulfill the objective the teachers were trained to develop the E-content and share that with students. Various lectures were arranged on different topics like Sorting, Filtering, Creating and Entering Data in Excel Sheet, Response management of Google Form, Google Classroom, Creating Video Lectures and Uploading on YouTube. Further the teachers were given assignments on daily basis for practice. 52 teachers attended the workshop successfully.

A training programme on the topic “Basic Skills of Computer” was organised for non-teaching employees of (III + IV class) in collaboration with Dept. of Computer Science from 07.03.2022 to 16.03.2022. The objective of this workshop was to train the employees in using computers like formatting in MS Word, MS Excel, Installation of Window and Bookmaking or How to share Hyperlink etc. 10 members of non-teaching staff attended the 10 days workshop successfully.

A five days National Workshop on the topic “Vartman Paripreksh Me Vaidik Shiksha Ki Upyogita” was organised in collaboration with Arya Yuwati Parishad, under the Faculty Development Programme from 22.04.2022 to 27.04.2022 for teaching faculty, non-teaching staff as well as PG students. Subhash Sudha, MLA, Thanesar was the distinguished guest on this occasion. 54 Teachers and 10 non-teaching staff members participated in the workshop successfully.

On 05.07.2022, a National Webinar on “Intellectual Property Rights” was organised by IQAC in collaboration with Legal Literacy Cell. The main objective of the Webinar was to enlighten all the stakeholders and budding entrepreneurs about the Intellectual Property Rights, its need & importance. Two Resource persons were invited to deliver their deliberations on the topic. Prof. Anand Sharma, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Management, NIPER, Mohali, presented his talk on “IPR's Innovations, Competitions & Growth”. The other Resource Person, Dr. Sonika Sethi, Associate Prof., Dept. of English, S.D. College, Ambala Cantt presented her talk on

the topic “A Comprehensive view on IPR in Higher Education”, explaining the concept of plagiarism and its different types along with the difference between plagiarism and copyright infringement. She also threw light on “Fair Use of Doctrine”. Total 126 participants including faculty and PG students from different states participated in the event.

On 24.03.2022, A workshop on “Font and Formatting of Research Papers” was organised for faculty to make them well aware of the fonts and formatting skills for writing the research papers. Mr. Nitin, Depty. Supdt. and expert of ICT was invited to speak on the subject. He explained in detail about the Unicode as well as Kokila fonts and formatting skills in MS Word and addressed all the queries of teachers to their satisfaction.

AQAR 2020-21 was prepared and submitted successfully on 12.03.2022 through online mode on NAAC portal.

Proctorial Board

The college has constituted a Proctorial Board to deal with matters related maintaining discipline in the campus. Proctorial Board is chiefly responsible for monitoring that rules and regulations framed by institution are being understood and followed by the students. In this regard, during the session, 51 classwise tutorial groups of 35-40 students each were formed by chief tutor with faculty tutorial incharges. Tutorial incharges guided students about various issues i.e. discipline, moral values, hygiene, cleanliness, girls safety, cleanliness etc in their respective tutorial groups throughout the year. On 18th November, 2021 a meeting of tutorial representative was conducted under the chairmanship of Principal Madam, Dr. Vijeshwari Sharma to elect office bearers of the tutorial groups to award badges to all TR's. Library Committee

Arjun Singh Memorial Library of the college is being operated adroitly under the supervision of Dr. Pooja Sharma, the librarian. The Library provided book bank facility to the students. This facility was offered to the students who got 85% or more marks and was unable to purchase books. Students are encouraged to march forward and attain their goal. A book exhibition was organised by the library committee on 28.03.2022, in which various books of different genres like general knowledge, competitive exam books, reference books and literary magazines and letters were exhibited. Appreciating presentation of the exhibition, Mrs. Minakshi Thakral, Principal of college, categorically stated that along with enhancing the knowledge of the students, the purpose of exhibition was to create the interest for books among the students. She further added that using this immense resource of knowledge, they could move ahead on the path of research and hone their intellectual aptitude.

On 21st Sep., 2021, in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National College, Ladwa, the library committee organized national webinar on the topic 'Academic and Research Visibility'.

The purpose of this webinar was to enlighten the participants and validity of knowledge in contemporary scientific age.

Besides on the occasion of 75th Anniversary of Independence, library committee arranged the articles of freedom fighters and revolutionaries, the purpose of which was to make students familiar with Great History of our country. The holistic development of the students is a prominent objective of the library.

Scholarship Committee

The college strives to motivate and encourage all students to become educated par excellence. To promote education, college provides credible scholarships and financial supports to all deserving students. For this purpose scholarship committee was constituted in the college. The function of this committee was to encourage, develop and evaluate all scholarship programmes. During this session, the college facilitated many students to get scholarship under various schemes run by center or state government or philanthropist. The detail of various scholarship schemes as below:

Government Scholarships

- Post Matric Scholarship: 223 schedule class students, 210 backward Students with an amount of Rs.29,72,796/- and Rs.9,61,641/- respectively.
- Promotion of Science Exhibition (POSE): 2 students of science stream got benefitted of an amount of Rs.96,000/-.
- Haryana State Merit Scholarship: During this scheme, one student of college got benefitted with an amount of Rs.36,00/-.
- University Merit Scholarship: One student of college got benefitted with an amount of Rs.24,00/- . One student from arts faculty with math subject got an amount of Rs.36,00/- under Mrs. Parkash Rani Athwale Scholarship.
- National Scholarship: 19 students of minorities got benefitted with an amount of Rs.1,90,000/-.

Scholarship Schemes run by the College

- Meritorious Scholarship Scheme: As per previous year the students are receiving 85% or above marks in 10+2, 80% and above marks in university result of 1st and 2nd year graduation, 70% and above marks at entry level of post graduation and 65% and above marks in first year of post graduation, 10% students received Rs.2,000/- each and 20% students received Rs.1,000/- each in this session. 153 students got benefitted an amount of Rs.2,46,000/-.
- Merit-cum-Means Scholarship: Under this scheme, 5 students got benefitted with an amount of Rs.13,500/-.
- Fee Concession: 5 students got benefitted Rs.22,000/-.
- Fee Concession for Sports Students: To promote sports spirit among students, two sports students got benefitted of Rs.10,568/- as fee concession.

Scholarship by Philanthropist

- Km. Sangeeta Munjal Memorial Scholarship: 3 students got benefit of Rs.9,000/-.

Special Scholarship for Commerce Students on Merit-cum-Means basis

- Subject Specific award : For students of First, Second and Final Year.
- Students of UG (I, II, III) who secured maximum marks got various scholarships in Sanskrit Pandit Data Ram Sharma Scholarship, Smt. Uma Rani Scholarship and Smt. Bhagwanti Devi on Merit-cum-means basis and received an amount of Rs.1100/- respectively.

- Sh. Jodh Singh Memorial Scholarship for securing maximum marks in Sanskrit (I, II, III) an amount of Rs.1000/- given.
- Mrs. Anita Gupta Award an amount of Rs.10000/- was given to students of B.A. I, II, III for securing maximum marks in English.
- Mrs. Punam Goyal Economics Scholarship an amount of Rs.12000/- was given for six students of B.A. and B.Com for attaining maximum marks in Economics.
- Smt. Mahima Devi Memorial Scholarship Best Athlete was given an amount of Rs.1100/-.
- Scholarships given by 'Tejaswini'-Alumni Association: 10 students of the college received scholarship on merit-cum-means basis from Alumni Association fund, Rs.20000/- were given to the students.

Anti Ragging Cell

Anti Ragging Cell was constituted in the college to prevent ragging and to take anti-ragging measures as per the guidelines issued by the Supreme Court of India and U.G.C. Dr. Urmila Panghal was appointed as Nodal Officer. Anti Ragging squad was also constituted in which students of senior classes were involved. Anti Ragging measures taken by the college:-

- Anti Ragging warning was also mentioned in the institution's information booklet 'Adhar Patrika'.
- At the outset of the academic session, students were instructed and warned in the classes not to indulge in 'RAGGING'.
- Anti Ragging Posters were displayed on the key areas of the college to aware students that 'Ragging is a crime and directly or indirectly involving in ragging is a punishable act.
- Surprise visits by the members of Anti Ragging cell in main areas of the campus i.e. canteen, common room, sitting area near canteen, playground, water points, washrooms to curb 'Ragging'
- CCTV cameras are installed in the whole campus to check the activities of students.
- Different activities like Poster making competition or slogan writing competition or extension lectures on 'Anti-ragging' are organized to create awareness among students.
- On 17-02-2022 K.V. D.A.V. girls College organized State level E Poster Making Competition in which our three students participated and grabbed two positions. Payal of (Bsc III NM) got first prize and Palak of (BA III) got second Prize.
- On 10-06-2022 Poster Making Competition and Slogan Writing Competition was organized on the topic "Anti-ragging" under the guidance of Dr. Urmila Panghal, Convener, Anti Ragging Cell and Mrs. Sapna Arora and Mrs. Asha Malik (Members) in which 45 students participated. Entrepreneurship Development Cell

Under the direction of Dr. Shweta Saini (convener) and team members i.e. Mrs. Anju chawla, Dr. Neha, Mrs Veenu, Ms. Pooja, Ms. Manisha and Ms. Lorika on 6.06.2022 'Lippan Art and Handmade Jewellery' workshop was organized by Entrepreneurship Development Cell, Home Science Society and Fashion Designing Society in the college. The main objective of this workshop was to make girl students self-reliant and to encourage employment in handicrafts of Indian culture. A total of 114 girl students from different faculties of the college participated in this workshop. During the workshop, the students made various items of lippan art and handmade jewellery.

'Hastkala Exhibition' was organized on 9.06.2022 under the joint collaboration of Home Science Society, Fashion Designing Society and Entrepreneurship Development Cell. In this, various exquisite handmade artifacts by the students were displayed. In these artifacts, beautiful works like jewellery made by the students, gel candles, useful items from waste items, handmade embroidery cushions and dupatta, lipan art, mandala and doodle art and bouquet decoration etc. were displayed. On this occasion 220 girl students and 40 professors visited the exhibition.

ED Cell of the college organized an Extension Lecture on the occasion of "World Youth Skill Day" on 15.7.2022. The resource person of the lecture was Mrs. Sangeeta, owner of Crazy Printing Press and Mrs. Sunita Sharma, owner of Mansi Beauty Parlor. A total of 50 students participated in the lecture. The main objective behind the event was to motivate the students to start their ventures and become financially independent in the future.

Passport Committee

A passport committee had been constituted in the college under the convenership of Mrs. Prabhjot Kaur on 11.02.2022. The committee organised one day workshop in which students of various streams participated enthusiastically. About 160 students participated in it. In this workshop, Mrs. Prabhjot Kaur guided the students how to apply online for passport making, how to deposite the fee online, how to get online appointment for passport. Equal opportunity Cell

Equal opportunity cell act as a torch bearer of creating awareness of the concept of equal opportunity to one and all irrespective of gender, ability, socio-economic background, caste religion or language on the lines of UGC guidelines. It also ensures the effective implementation of policies and programmes for disadvantage groups. Equal opportunity cell organizes various activities to create awareness about "Equal opportunity to one and all" among students.

In this line, a Poster Competition and slogan writing competition on the topic 'Equal opportunity to all' was organized on 10 June, 2022 under the guidance of Dr. Urmila Panghal (Convener, Equal opportunity cell) and Dr. Upasana (Member). Total 45 Students Participated in both competitions. In poster Making competition Pallavi (B.com I) got first position. Kashish Gandhi (B.com II) and Megha (B.sc I) grabbed second and third position. Rashi (BA I) and Pawanpreet (B.sc II) got consolation Prizes.

National Education Policy Committee

As per instruction received from K.U.K., National Education Policy Committee comprising of Dr. Urmila Panghal as convener, Dr. Upasana, Dr. Himani, Dr. Suman Rajan, Dr. Arti, Dr. Pooja Sharma, Mrs. Sapna Arora, Mrs. Reena, Mrs. Asha, Mrs. Shilpa, Mr. Nitin as the members was constituted. As per directions received from K.U.K. three members, Dr. Urmila Panghal, Dr. Upasana and Dr. Himani attended five days workshop on “Implementation of N.E.P-2020” organized by IIHS, K.U.K from June 13 to 17, 2022.

On 27.06.2022, UGC organised online consultation meeting on 'Implimentation on NHEQF' in Higher Educational Institutions. The live telecast of this meeting was organised in the College in which Prof. M. Jagdish Kumar, Chairman, UGC, Dr. N.S. Kalsi, chairman, NCVET and Prof. M.P. Poonia, Vice Chairman, AICTE presented their deliberations and resolved querries raised by participants. Total 33 teachers attended this event.

A three day workshop was organized in the college from July 1 to 4, 2022 to educate and train all the faculty members about the various aspects regarding “Implementation of “NEP 2020”. Total 50 teachers attended the workshop in the College.

In the series of 3 days of the workshop, The following lectures were delivered by three resource persons as per schedule:

Dr. Upasana, in her lecture, covered the various aspects of National Education Policy e.g. need of National Education Policy, the inclusion of equitable and quality education, skill enhancement, lifelong learning opportunities, to enhance logical thinking and creativity, Indian value based education. She also threw light on some key points to be addressed by the institution while implementing the National Education Policy -2020 like constitution of a strong Counselling cell to guide students, to provide ample opportunities for employment, to enhance scholarships at institution level and strengthening of different departments etc. The changes regarding fee structure, required infrastructure to start new vocational courses were also discussed in detail. Further she told that every institution has to prepare its institutional development plan (IDP) in advance as the main focus of NEP-2020 is to obsolete single stream institution and to promote multi-disciplinary institution. The main objective of this education policy is to make every institution autonomous upto 2030 and to project India as “Vishva Guru” in the field of education.

Dr. Urmila Panghal in her lecture discussed about “Multiple Entry & Exit” system and told that how this system gives flexibility and opportunity to the learners a lifelong learning. She discussed in detail the various aspects of NEP-2020 that after implementation of NEP-2020, the system will give freedom to the learners to choose the subjects of their interest irrespective of stream and to complete their education in flexible mode with their own pace. She emphasised on the process to be adopted for the different levels like Certificate level, Diploma level, Degree level & Research level while completing and exiting the system at different stages. Her deliberation also covered the various areas like vocational courses, CBCS system, internships and continuous comprehensive evaluation system.

Dr. Himani in her deliberation emphasized that “**Academic Bank of Credits**” will act as a virtual store house to maintain the record of student's data. All institutions which are graded A and above by NAAC, will be entitled to get register on 'ABC'. In present time, university will initiate to register on ABC along with its affiliated institutions. The credits deposited in Academic Bank will be valid for maximum seven years which can be redeemed from anywhere, at anytime, even in any foreign university also. So the students will be able to fulfill the criterias of global education.

The Workshop was concluded with vote of thanks by Principal Madam Mrs. Minakshi Thakral. She also praised the resource persons for their enlightening deliberations and motivated all the staff members to contribute their best in the implementation of NEP-2020 successfully so that the institution may prove its existence and liability towards the growth & development of country.

On 07.07.2022 three days education summit, Akhil bhartiya Shiksha Smagam was organised at Varanasi, UP from 07.07.2020 to 09.07.2022 to discuss, to deliberate, share insights on strategies, success stories and best practices in implementing the NEP-2020. The live telecast of inaugural event on 7th July, 2022 was arranged in the college in which Honorable Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi ji delivered inaugural address. Total 107 Students, teaching and non-teaching staff attended the event.

Under MOU between Dayanand Mahila Mahavidyalaya and Sanatan Dharam College, Ambala Cantt., 7 teaching faculty of IQAC and National Education Policy Committee of our College visited S.D. College Ambala Cantt on 19.07.2022. The main objective of this visit was to get information regarding :-

Discussions were held regarding above mentioned point after that Dr. Rajender Rana, Principal, S.D. The concept of alumni association evolved to foster a spirit of loyalty and belongingness to Alma mater among alumni by being in regular contact with them. Alumni Association of college was constituted in 2001-02 but it got registered under Haryana Registration and Regulation Societies Act 2012 named as Tejaswini in August 2019. The main aim of Tejaswini was to unite maximum number of ex-students and register them in this alumni family to promote education. Activities conducted by Tejaswini Alumni Association in 2021-22:

ADD ON COURSES

Fashion Designing

A fashion designing (Add on Course) being run in the college under the convenership of Dr. Shweta Saini. 34 students get enrolled for certificate course while 3 students got enrolled for advanced diploma course in the session 2021-22. The purpose of this course to make the students self-reliant.

In Certificate course students are trained in sketching, shading, painting, hand printing, stencil printing and tie and dye. In diploma course, students are trained in drafting, cutting and stitching (plazzo and frock). In advance diploma students learnt embroidery painting on traditional dresses and designing saree making. On following syllabuses and getting proper training, students can move forward in the field of fashion-designing and in future, they can become self-dependent adopting it as their profession. In the session fashion designing cell in collaboration with home science society and entrepreneurship cell lipped art and hand-made jewellery workshop. The purpose of this workshop was to make the students self-dependent and to promote and art and craft, opportunities of Indian culture.

In the same session, all the above mentioned societies collectively organised 'art and craft' exhibition (hand-made). In this exhibition, student exhibited their hand made jewellery, Jell Candles, best out of waste, cushions of hand made embroidery, lipped art dupatta, mandale and duddal art and decorative vases and pots.

Secretarial Practice

Commerce Department is running one year certificate Add-on-course in Secretarial Practice. During session 2021-22 total 5 students got enrolled in this course. All students completed this course successfully. This course helped students to develop skills in performing office jobs and to learn maintaining office records by using technology. This course enhances job opportunities. Students also got experience of shorthand and computer typing which will enhance their professional career.

Counselling and Psychotherapy

Counselling and Psychotherapy one year certificate course was being run by the college under supervision of Mrs. Urmila Singh in the session 2021-22. Eight students were enrolled from all streams. This course has three papers. One is theoretical part of Counselling areas and different psychotherapies to bring change in behaviour's Modification. Second part practical related with Counselling need areas, Parent-child relationship, emotional adjustment and anxiety related aspects. Third part is related to case study and project work. Counselling techniques and Psychotherapies methods were told to the students. So that they may able to solve their Behavioural, Emotional and Personal Problems and developing insight, self confidence & decision making power and be mentally fit. Students were told about Counselling for Alcohol & substance Abusers. This course includes Drug De-addiction Programme and their rehabilitation as drug abuse is increasing day by day among youth. Seven students were awarded certificates after successful competition of course.

VALUE ADDED COURSE

Basics of Marketing

Total 94 Students were enrolled from all streams in this course. Students enthusiastically attended the classes and were awarded certificates after successful completion of this course. The main objective of this course was to acquaint the students with conceptual knowledge of marketing and provide students an understanding of expectations of industry and make them industry ready. It would enhance their career opportunities.

Retail Management

Commerce Department is running 30 contact hours value added course in “Retail Management”. In odd semester of the session 2021-22 total 40 students got enrolled in this course. 40 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring knowledge of Retail Management strategies, structures and how to minimize threats in retailing by use of IT tools.

Nutrition & Fitness

A Value added course in Nutrition & Fitness is being run in the college under the directions of Dr. Shweta Saini. This is a short term course of 30 contract hours opted by students of any stream. During the session a total of Fifty five students took admission in the course. Objective of this course is to educate the students about the principles of fitness and nutrition such as body composition, energy intake, energy expenditure as well as the acute and chronic physical changes related to exercise and nutrition which complement each other in helping to develop physiological well-being and overall health.

Stress Management

Psychology Department is running 30 contact hours Value Added Course in “Stress Management” from the session 2018-19. Indian Constitution

Political Science Department is running 30 contact hours Value Added Course in “Indian Constitution” from the session 2020-21. In odd semester of the session 2021-22 total 85 students got enrolled in this course. All the 85 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring the knowledge of different fundamental articles which are included in Indian Constitution. Indian National Movement

Mental Health

Psychology Department started 30 contact hours Value Added Course in “Mental Health” from even semester of the session 2021-22. A Value added course in Best out of waste is being run in the college under the directions of Dr. Shweta Saini. This is a short term course of 30 contract hours opted by students of any stream. During the session a total of thirty students took admission in the course. Objective of this course is to educate the students about the optimal use of waste material to create innovative products. This course enables students to develop fantastic and usable products by recycling and reusing the valuable waste material by exploring the environmental concepts and actions which are beyond the curriculum and syllabus.

HTML

Computer Science Department started 30 contact hours value added course in HTML from even semester of the session 2021-22. Total 94 students got enrolled in this course from which 92 students completed this course successfully. From this course students learned all the basic and advance tags like frames and forms of HTML and by the end of this course, students were able to design a web page using HTML.

Library Management of Information Science

Library Department is running 30 contact hours value added course in Library Management and Information Science of the session 2021-22. Total 40 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring knowledge and enhances the skill of organizing library information and recorded knowledge.

Personality Development

A value added course of 30 contact hours was offered to the students in the Even Semester of 2021-22. Punjabi Lok Geet

Total 23 students got enrolled in Punjabi Lok Geet Course. Punjabi Department start this value added course of 30 hours in session 2021-2022.
