IQAC

- On 16.11.2022 & 17.11.2022, Principal Mrs. Minakshi Thakral & IQAC, convener Mrs. Anju Chawla participated in Handholding program organised jointly by DGHE, Panchkula & NAAC, Bengaluru. This Program was organised in Tagore Theare of MD University, Rohtak.
- On 06.01.2023, IQAC, on behalf of the college, participated in NIRF-2023 (National Institute Ranking Framework)
- On 24.01.2023, Conveners & members of IQAC & NEP Committee attended a meeting with Prof. Anita Dua in IIHS, KUK, The main purpose of this meeting was to collect the information regarding admission process under NEP-2020.
- On 27.01.2023, One Day workshop on the topic “Admission Process for Next Academic Session Under NEP-2020” was organised jointly by IQAC & NEP committee of the college. The workshop was attended by 27 teachers. Dr. Urmila Panghal was the main speaker of the workshop.
- On 31.03.2023, IQAC prepared Institutional Development Plan of the college and uploaded the same on the portal of IDP launched by DGHE, Panchkula.
- On 31.03.2023, IQAC uploaded Information and Data of the college on PRAYAS portal.
- On 28.02.2023, IQAC submitted Annual Quality Assurance Report of the college for the session 2021-22 on NAAC portal.

ADD ON COURSES

Fashion Designing

Fashion Designing (Add-on-course) is being run in the college under the guidance of Dr. Shweta Saini and Mrs. Akanksha, Convener of Fashion Designing Society. In the session 2022-23, total 26 students took admission in certificate course and 9 students in diploma course. The aim of these courses is to make girls self-reliant. During the certificate course, the girl students took training in sketching, shading, painting, block printing, hand printing, stencil printing and tie and dye etc. Under the diploma course, the girl students got training in drafting, cutting and stitching (designer suits, Palazzo suits and frocks). In these courses, girl students can move forward in the field of fashion designing by getting proper training and in the near future, by becoming self-reliant, they can also run their livelihood sitting at home.

On 17.2.2023, a workshop on 'Madhubani and Pichwai Painting' was organized by the Home Science Society, Fashion Designing Society and Entrepreneurship Cell in the college premises, in which girl students were trained to make Madhubani and Pichwai paintings. A total of 116 girl students participated in this workshop and after getting knowledge about this art form from Mrs. Akanksha, they made various items.

State level 'Best out of Waste' and 'Pot Decoration Competition' was organized by the Home Science Society, Fashion Designing Society and Entrepreneurship Cell on 8.4.2023 on the occasion of State Level Fest 'Anugoonj' organised by our institute. On this occasion, a total of 32 participants from different colleges participated in Best Out of Waste and 32 participants in Pot Decoration Competition. Ms. Anjali (BA 1st) of Dayanand Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Kurukshetra stood first in Best out of Waste competition. Ms. Mary (B.Com 3rd) of Dayanand Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Kurukshetra stood first, Ms. Nidhi (BSc II 2nd) of Dayanand Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Kurukshetra stood second in pot decoration competition.

On 24.04.2023, a workshop was organized by the Home Science Society, Fashion Designing Society and Entrepreneurship Cell on the working of 'Usha Fashion Maker' in which a total of 61 girl students participated. In this workshop, the girl students got information about the various products made by Usha Fashion Maker and its functions.

Secretarial Practice

Commerce Department is running one year certificate Add-on-course in Secretarial Practice. During session 2022-23 total 6 students got enrolled in this course. All students completed this course successfully. This course helped students to develop skills in performing office jobs and to learn maintaining office records by using technology. This course enhances job opportunities. Students also got experience of shorthand on computer which will enhance their professional career.

Counselling and Psychotherapy

Counselling and Psychotherapy one year certificate course is being run by the college under supervision of Mrs. Urmila Singh in the session 2022-23. Two students were enrolled. This course has three papers. One is theoretical part of Counselling areas and different psychotherapies to bring change in behavioural modification. Second part was practical related with counselling need areas: Parent-child relationship, emotional adjustment and anxiety related aspects. Third part is related to case study and project work. Counselling techniques and Psychotherapies methods were told to the students. So that they may be able to solve their Behavioural, Emotional and Personal Problems and can develop insight, self confidence & decision making power and be mentally fit. Students were told about counselling for alcohol & substance abusers. This course includes drug de-addiction Programme and their rehabilitation as drug abuse is increasing day by day among youth. Seven students were awarded certificates after successful completion of course.

VALUE ADDED COURSE

Basics of Marketing

Total 54 Students were enrolled from all streams in this course. Students enthusiastically attended the classes and were awarded certificates after successful completion of this course. The main objective of this course was to acquaint the students with conceptual knowledge of marketing and provide students an understanding of expectations of industry and make them industry ready. It would enhance their career opportunities.

Retail Management

Commerce Department is running 30 contact hours value added course in “Retail Management”. In odd semester of the session 2022-23 total 41 students got enrolled in this course. 41 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring knowledge of Retail Management strategies, structures and how to minimize threats in retailing by use of IT tool.

Nutrition & Fitness

A Value added course in Nutrition & Fitness is being run in the college under the direction of Dr. Shweta Saini. This is a short term course of 30 contact hours opted by students of any stream. During the session a total of eighty students completed the course. Objective of this course is to educate the students about the principles of fitness and nutrition such as body composition, energy intake, energy expenditure as well as the acute and chronic physical changes related to exercise and nutrition which complement each other in helping to develop physiological well-being and overall health.

Indian Constitution

Political Science Department is running 30 contact hours Value Added Course in “Indian Constitution” from the session 2022-23. In odd semester of the session 2022-23 total 54 students got enrolled in this course. All the 54 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring the knowledge of different fundamental articles which are included in Indian Constitution. This will make students aware about their fundamental rights and duties.

Science Around Us

Value added course ‘Science Around Us’ was started by Chemistry & Physics Department in session 2022-23. Total 55 students enrolled in the course & 55 students completed the course successfully. The main objective to run this course was to encourage scientific temperament among students about various phenomenon occurring in their day to day life.

Yoga and Meditation

A value added course in yoga and meditation is being run from 22nd Sept. to 21st Dec., 2022 in the college under the directions of Dr. Anu Chauhan. This is a short term course of 30 contact hours opted by student of any stream. Total 102 students enrolled in this course and Total 92 students completed this course. Objective of this course is to impart various skills among students related to physical and mental fitness as well as to develop correct posture habits through the practice of different yogasans.

Mental Health

Psychology Department started 30 contact hours Value Added Course in “Mental Health” from odd semester of the session 2022-23. Total 89 students got enrolled in this course and all the students completed this course successfully. From this course students acquired knowledge regarding symptoms, causes and treatment of various mental disorders. This course enhanced their knowledge regarding causes of mental retardation and ill effects of drug addiction and rehabilitation. This course helped students to recognize early signs & risks of mental illness by following mental health promotional techniques taught in the classroom.

Best Out of Waste

A Value added course in Best out of waste is being run in the college under the directions of Dr. Shweta Saini. This is a short term course of 30 contact hours opted by students of any stream. During the session a total of 65 students took admission in the course. Objective of this course is to educate the students about the optimal use of waste material to create innovative products. This course enables students to develop fantastic and usable products by recycling and reusing the valuable waste material by exploring the environmental concepts and actions which are beyond the curriculum and syllabus.

HTML

Computer Science Department started 30 contact hours value added course in HTML from odd semester of the session 2022-23. Total 83 students got enrolled in this course from which 83 students completed this course successfully. From this course students learned all the basic and advance tags like frames and forms of HTML and by the end of this course, students were able to design a web page using HTML.

Library Management Information Science

Library Department is running 30 contact hours value added course in Library Management and Information Science of the session 2022-23. Total 79 students completed this course successfully. This course benefitted students by acquiring knowledge and enhances the skill of organizing library information and recorded knowledge.

Personality Development

A value added course of 30 contact hours was offered to the students in the odd and even Semester of 2022-23. The course initiative was taken in collaboration with Heartfulness Education Trust (HET), an Andhra Pradesh, and India based trust. The course was offered to the students with an aim of their overall personality development based on the five major pillars i.e. leadership, heartfulness, meditation, heart and inner well being. Various offline and online workshops and counselling sessions were organised by the faculty from all over India through online as well as offline mode. The course has been very helpful for the students to feel more inspired, bold and capable of bringing change in self and society. Total 121 in odd semester and 17 in even semester students were enrolled and all the students completed this course successfully.

Soft Skills

Total 72 Students were enrolled from all streams in this course. Students enthusiastically attended the classes and were awarded certificates after successful completion of this course. The main objective of this course was to enhance the communication skills of the students for their career growth. Students of different streams learnt different skills from this course.

Tally

Total 30 Students were enrolled from all streams in this course in collaboration with ACA Academy, Kurukshetra. Students enthusiastically attended the classes and were awarded certificates after successful completion of this course. The main objective of this course was to enhance the organization of business data of a company for their career growth. Students of different streams learnt different skills from this course.

Punjabi Lok Geet

Total 25 students got enrolled in Punjabi Lok Geet Course. Punjabi Department started this value added course of 30 hours in session 2022-2023. From this course students learnt different types of Punjabi Lok Geet that helped them to stay connected to the traditional rituals and Cultural Heritage of Punjabi Culture in the present scenario.

Reasoning & Quantitative Aptitude

A value added course of Reasoning & Quantitative Aptitude was run by Mathematics Department in odd and even semester. For this course of 30 contact hours, a M.O.U. was signed with Toppers Point Academy of Kurukshetra.
